

Drop-off Point Guidance

Thank you for considering becoming a Drop-off Point for Malaptop!



A Drop-off Point is simply somewhere that people can go and donate a laptop to Malaptop. We are looking to have as many Drop-off Points as possible throughout Scotland so that people are not putting off donating their laptop due to distance. The Drop-off Points can either be local schools, churches, businesses or any other public building. This is a great way to help Malaptop with no financial implication.

What would be required of a Drop-off Point

- Be able to take donations of laptops during specified hours (e.g. Mon-Fri, 9am - 5pm)
- Collecting the Donation forms and keeping them safe until collected
- Keeping in contact with the Malaptop team so we know how many you have
- Let people know that you are a Drop-off Point by allowing us to put the location on the Malaptop website, and having a sign/poster on site.

What would not be required of a Drop-off Point

- Any work done to the laptops, we are not asking the Drop-off Points to help prepare the laptops and so no computing work will need to be carried out at the Drop-off Point.
- Long-term mass storage. We will collect from the Drop-off Points regularly and if at any point you feel that your storage facilities are being stretched we will try and come and collect them as soon as possible.
